The Crimson King Norway Maple is distinctive for its red-purple leaves during the growing season. The tree has a symmetrical canopy and can grow quite large. Leaves are a typical 5-lobed maple shape with pointed tips, wider than they are long. There is no noticeable Fall color change. The leaf stem produces a milky sap when removed from the branch. Fruit is a winged samara.

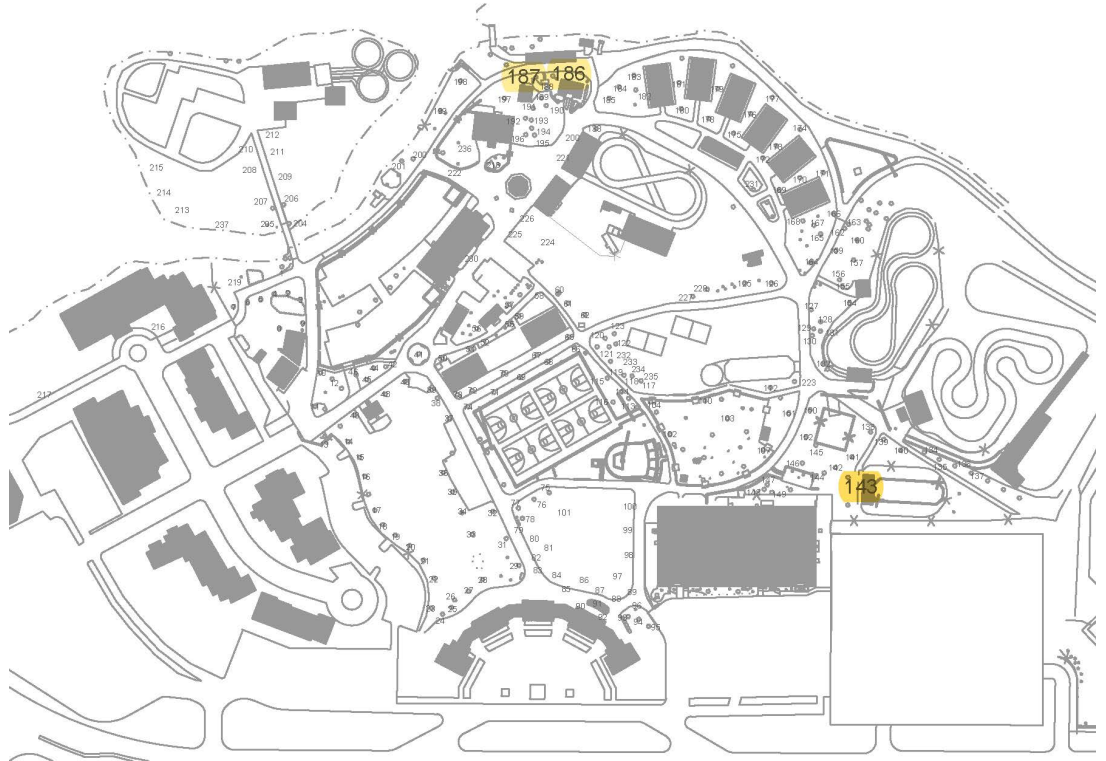
