The Dawn Redwood is a fast-growing, deciduous conifer. The habit is pyramidal-conical with a single, straight trunk. Fine, green needles turn orange-brown and drop in Fall. Bark is red-brown and exfoliates in long, narrow strips. The base of the trunk is distinct for the buttressing shape.

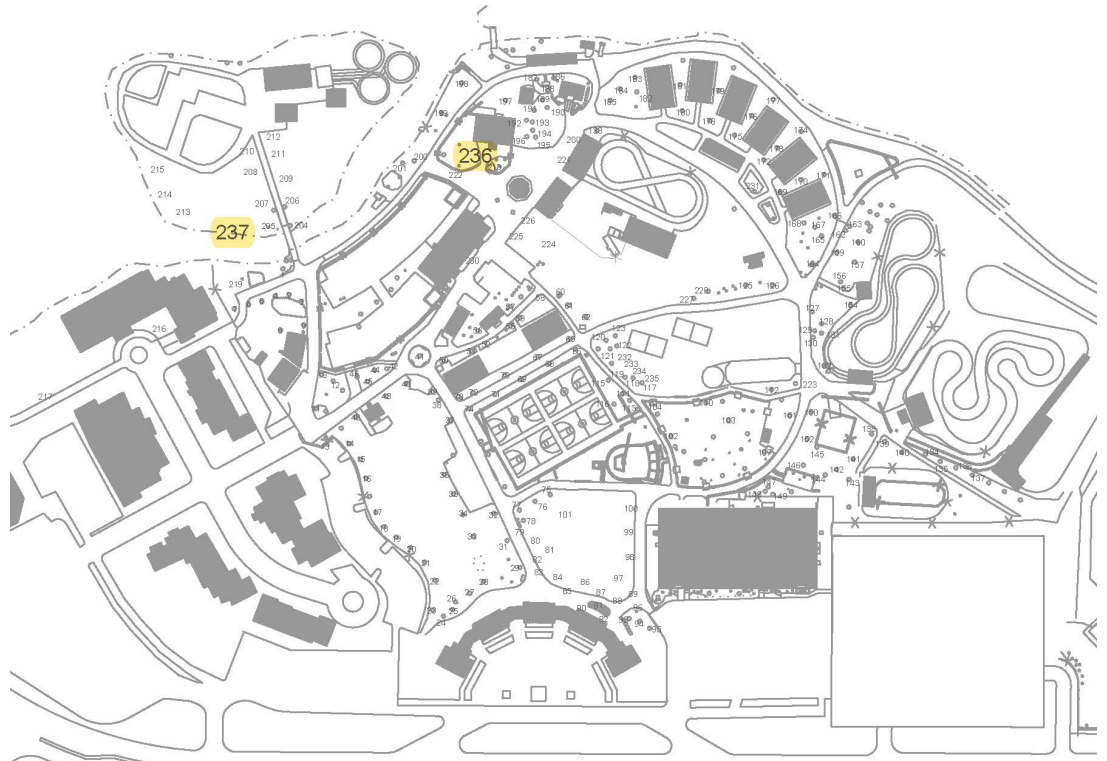
