The Amur Corktree is a broad-spreading tree with a short trunk and a medium texture created by compound leaves with 5-11 leaflets. It has thick, corky or spongy outer bark, and yellow inner bark. Mature specimens exhibit a furrowed, gray-brown bark pattern. Leaves are dark green in Summer and change to yellow in Fall. The leaves and fruit have a distinctive smell when crushed.

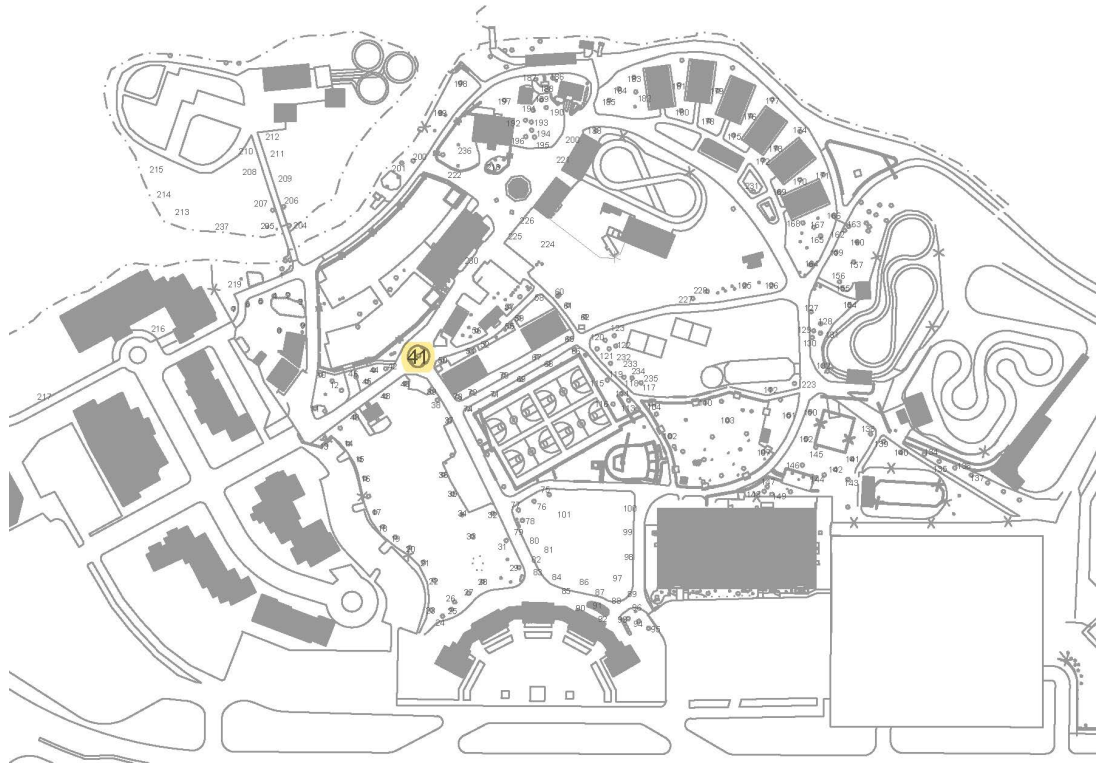
