Newfoundland to Manitoba, south to Georgia, Illinois and Iowa  
The Eastern White Pine is a fast-growing conifer. The habit is pyramidal when young, becoming more open and plume-like with age. Bluish-green 2-4" needles are in bundles of five, and are soft to the touch. Cones are 6-8" long by 1-1/2" wide and light brown. The species is valuable as construction timber.

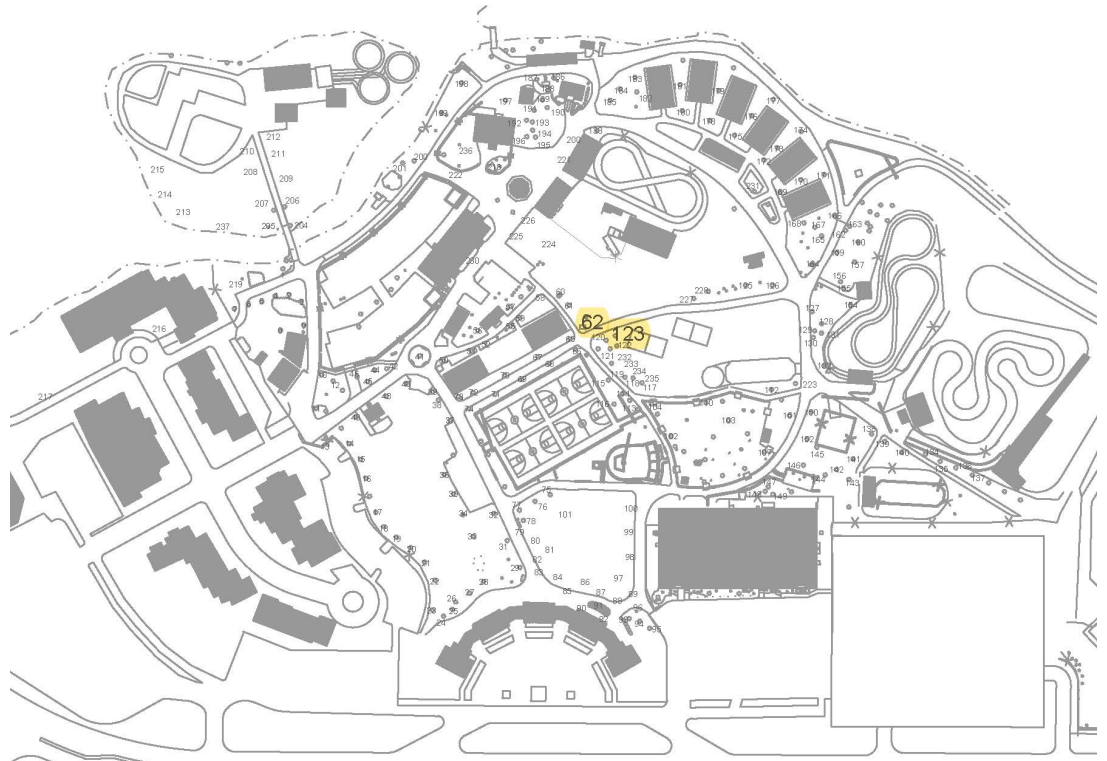
