The London Planetree is a large, medium-coarse tree with a pyramidal habit when young, becoming more open with age. Large medium-dark green leaves turn yellow-brown in Fall. The distinctive, smooth bark pattern develops with age, peeling off to reveal green, gray, and tan colorations. Fruits are small, soft, brown globes that can often be seen hanging on through winter.

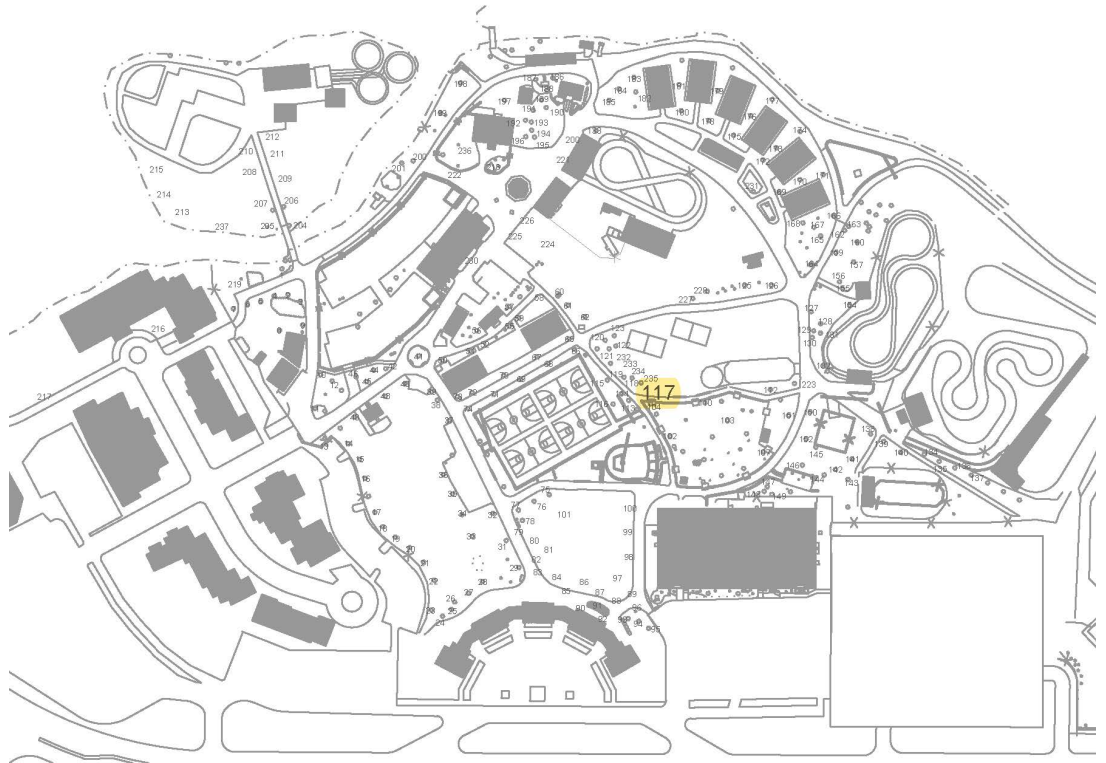
