The Bradford Flowering Pear is a fast-growing deciduous tree with a pyramidal habit that rounds with age. Leaves are dark green and glossy, about as wide as long. Leaves turn red-purple in Fall. An abundance of white flowers appear in Spring before the leaves open. Fruit is small and non-ornamental.
