



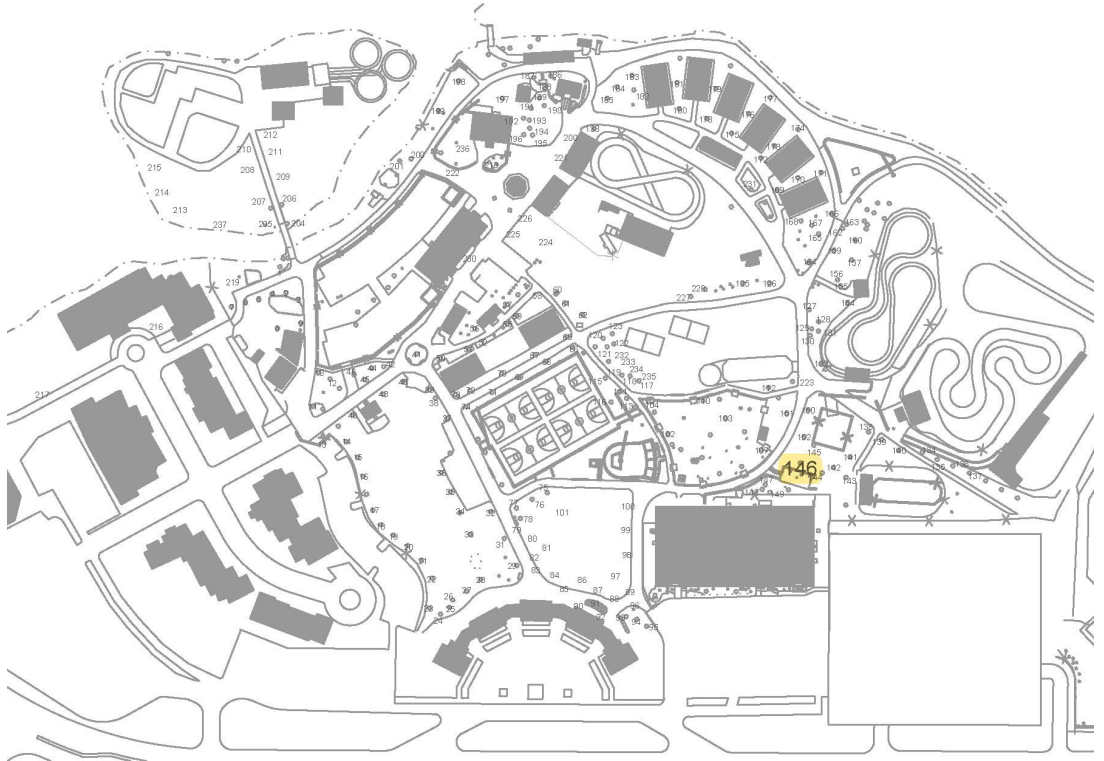

The Common Pear is a fruit-producing tree, and the parent of many commercial orchard trees. White flowers produced in early Spring are susceptible to frost. Dark green, elliptical leaves turn red and yellow in Fall. Bark is gray-brown and develops a scale-like appearance with age.
