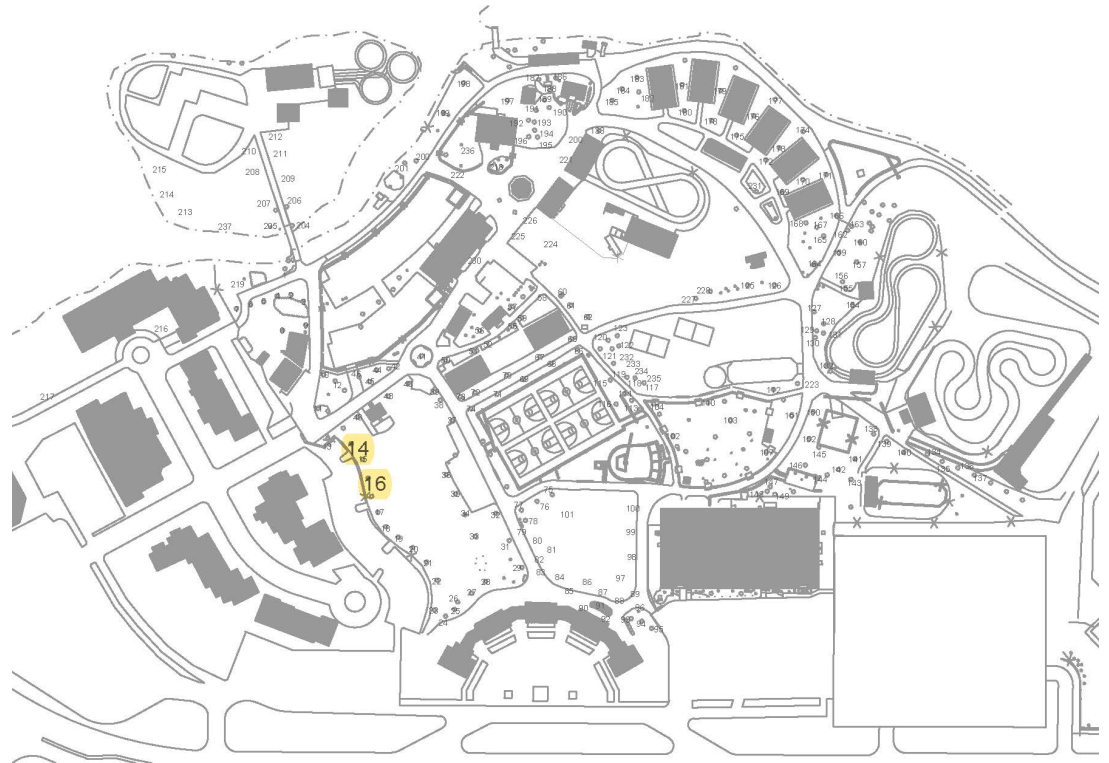

The Swamp White Oak has a broad-open crown on a short trunk. Dark green, shiny leaves are oblong with rounded lobes, have a pale underside, and turn yellow in Fall. Catkins are small and are followed by 1" acorns. They are often found in wet areas.
