



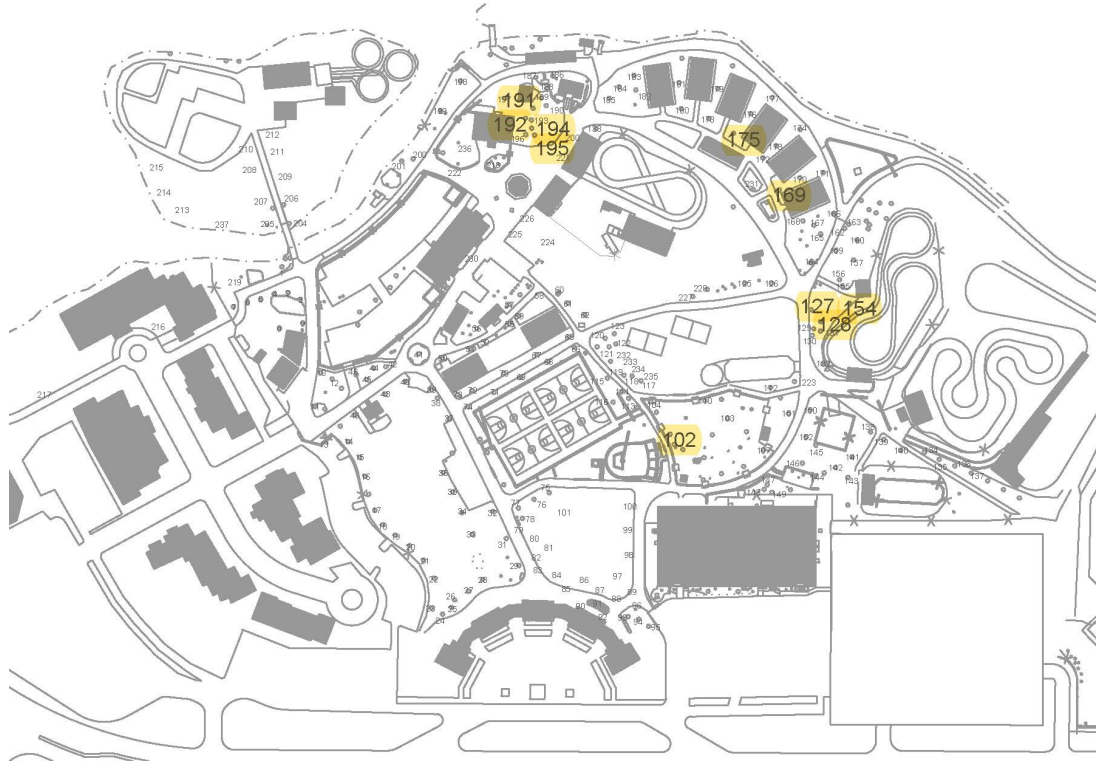

Nova Scotia to Pennsylvania, west to Minnesota and Iowa  
The Red Oak is a fast-growing oak species. The habit is more rounded and symmetrical. Leaf tips are pointed, but lobes are wider than Pin Oak. In Fall, the leaves turn russet-red. Acorns are produced early and are a food source for wildlife.
